TO BE SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT WISHING TO RECEIVE SUPPORT FROM THE WIPO VOLUNTARY FUND FOR ACCREDITED INDIGENOUS AND LOCAL COMMUNITIES,

FOR THE FIFTY-SECOND SESSION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND GENETIC RESOURCES, TRADITIONAL KNOWLEDGE AND FOLKLORE

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

- 1. This form consists of three parts, all sections of which must be <u>completed</u>:
 - Part A to be completed and signed by the <u>observer organization previously</u>
 <u>accredited</u> by WIPO or the Intergovernmental Committee on Intellectual Property
 and Genetic Resources, Traditional Knowledge and Folklore ("the IGC"),
 <u>representing</u> local or indigenous communities or other customary holders or
 custodians of traditional knowledge or traditional cultural expressions.
 - Part B to be completed and signed by the <u>applicant</u> wishing to benefit from the Fund, nominated by the previously accredited observer organization.
 - Please note that the WIPO Director General will invite all funded participants in
 the future to submit a brief and structured report about their own participation in
 the meeting for which they might be funded. Such report will be annexed to their
 application for due consideration by the Advisory Board, should those funded
 applicants decide to reapply for funding¹.
 - Part C will include the résumé (or curriculum vitae) of the applicant which, especially highlights the <u>places</u> where he/she has been living and conducting his/her various activities in promoting local and indigenous communities' interests.
- 2. <u>If the organization which nominates the applicant is not previously accredited as an observer either by WIPO or the IGC, the submitted application cannot be considered valid</u>
- 3. If you wish to participate (with funding from the Voluntary Fund) in the said IGC session but you are **not** a representative of a previously accredited organization, that organization should begin by submitting a request for accreditation to the IGC and it must obtain that accreditation *before* being eligible to submit an application to the Fund.

Decisions on accreditation are made by the Member States at the beginning of each session of the IGC. Non-governmental organizations requesting to be accredited as an observer at the IGC should complete a form. This form is available at the following address: http://www.wipo.int/tk/en/igc/participation.html. Completed forms should be received by the WIPO Secretariat at least two months prior to each session of the IGC, preferably by email to grtkf@wipo.int.

It is also possible for an organization to obtain an accreditation by decision of the WIPO General Assembly. Please contact the Secretariat if you wish to receive information on this procedure.

4. <u>Deadline for submission of the applications form by persons wishing to receive financial support</u>

To be taken into consideration with a view to the possible funding for the applicant's participation in the 52nd session of the IGC, this form, <u>completed</u>, in its <u>original</u> and <u>duly signed</u>, must <u>reach</u> the International Bureau of WIPO **on March 30**, **2025** the **latest**.

The 52nd session of the IGC may take place in 2026, pending the renewal of the mandate of the IGC by the WIPO General Assembly.
